#### Curriculum vitae

I was born in 1953 in Aue/Saxonia. After finishing school education in 1972 I studied physics at Humboldt-University in Berlin. I started research work in the field of experimental semiconductor physics (development of luminescence and laser diodes) and got the diploma degree in 1977. Although I was interested in fundamental research, there was no corresponding position offered to me due to my political inactivity. After several years in industrial R&D departments (measuring techniques for light sources, development of electronic steerings in machine building), I worked from 1984 to 1987 at the Joint Institute for Nuclear Research Dubna (USSR). In the group of Prof. I. Golutvin, I participated in a facility study for the muon spectrometer of the neutrino tagging experiment under development at Serpukhov. Further, I took part in some phenomenological investigations connected with gauge boson decays (D. Bardin et al.) and elastic hadron nucleon scattering (AJAX-SIGMA Collab.). Since 1988 I work at the Institute for High Energy Physics Zeuthen/Brandenburg. For some time I dealt with simulation software for rare charged kaon decays in the above-mentioned neutrino collaboration. In connection with my interest to work on a Ph. D. thesis, now I join the local Zeuthen L3 group. I am taking part in some investigations connected with Bhabha scattering.
